I don't know how this happened, disk cache is not set higher than allocated memory.

IIRC (hasn't happened for 5 years or more) I need to replace the ..cfg file. Of course, now I can't find my Paris install disc.
Anybody able to shoot me a .cfg file from thier install disc?
