It's the last of the usable x2-939 motherboards. Not sure I would bother with it now though. The board has been discontinued and is a dead end for upgrades and such.

If you are looking to up grade from a pre 939 based AMD system then it will be a waste. At this point I would only recommend a Intel Core 2 Duo 975 chipset based system.

Significantly faster better upgrade path and can be got for similar prices.
